

During the exams' week, you will sit two GCSE style papers: a Reading paper and a Listening paper. These papers will test your general French comprehension and, in order to prepare for these examinations, you will need to revise both topics studied this year: Lifestyle and Leisure.

In the weeks following the exams but before the end of term, your teacher will set a Written controlled assessment task and a Speaking controlled assessment task which you will prepare during lesson time and then complete under controlled conditions. More information on how to do well in these tasks will be given after the exams' week.

The make-up of the exam is as follows:

1. Year Tests (25%)
2. Pronunciation Test (10%)
3. Reading Test (35%)
4. Listening Test (30%)
